

Is My Child Eligible for the Free NC Pre-Kindergarten Program?

If your child is **four years old** by August 31 of the school year and your family meets the income requirements (below), your child is eligible for the NC Pre-K program!

Complete an application and return it as soon as possible to the Alliance for Children at 105 Cedar Street, Monroe NC. See more details, applications forms and health assessment forms on our website at www.theAllianceforChildren.org.

NC Pre-K (formerly More at Four) is a high quality state program designed to help four year old children strengthen academic and social skills before entering Kindergarten.

The program is free for eligible families

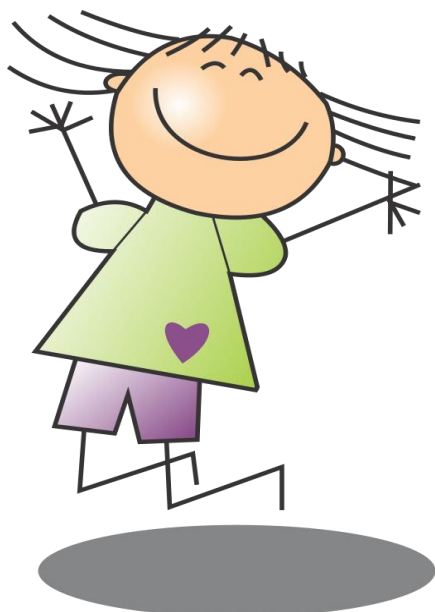
and based on school year calendars. Parents provide transportation each day.

There are public school and childcare sites serving NC Pre-K students throughout Union County.

Income eligibility for NC Pre-K is determined by family size and gross income.
