- 4. Licensed teachers utilize the Creative Curriculum® to guide child-based developmentally appropriate learning.

NC Pre-Kindergarten – Alliance for Children - Child's NC Pre-K class hours are FREE, there is no charge to families. Eligible families are contacted by the site after the child is placed. Applications for wait list are welcomed all year.

To be eligible, families must meet income guidelines. Example: A family of four is eligible for NC Pre-K with income less than \$74,393. Information (FAQ) and Income Eligibility Table: www.theallianceforchildren.org under NC Pre-K.

NC Pre-K sites **(A)** offer limited extended care *before and/or after NC Pre-K hours* for a fee. You arrange with the director of the site before school begins. Parents pay the site for all time before or after the NC Pre-K Day. To apply for an income-based childcare voucher, call 704-296-4339 and leave a message.
