

Highlights - Year In Review

- The Dolly Parton Imagination Library continues to grow in Union County.
 This year the DPIL has mailed 73,435 books serving 6,200 children. We
 continue to partner with Atrium Health Union to offer the program to
 every newborn.
- NC Pre-Kindergarten served 307 children in 21 classrooms. NC Pre-K provided a high-quality educational experience to enhance school readiness.
- The 68th Annual Union County Christmas Parade was held in person with over 150 entries. We crowned the Parade Princess at the Shops at Nottingham.
- Celebrated Week of the Young Child by passing out books to children promoting how reading helps to build brains, while parents learned about Alliance for Children and the programs we offer.
- Our State Legislators and Community Leaders read to classrooms in celebration of Week of the Young Child.
- Participated in Indian Trail's Family Fun Day that saw over 3,000 children receive books and their families received information on Alliance for Children's services such as Dolly Parton Imagination Library and Circle of Parents.
- PetSmart once again partnered with us to receive 1,900 animals used as "Reading Buddies" to promote Dolly Parton Imagination Library, and encourage early literacy.

Best Start:

• **43** Parents and **30** children impacted by home visits, group meetings counseling sessions, academic intervention

Breastfeeding Support:

• 768 Parents impacted through prenatal breastfeeding classes, peer support, peer counseling

Child Care subsidy:

• 1203 Children impacted through providing financial support for quality child care

Circle of Parents:

• 8 Parents and 9 Children impacted through coach and peer run support sessions for children with disabilities

Education Stars:

• **88** Educators Served through higher education advising, tuition assistance, certificate/diploma/degree completion

Inclusion Support:

- 15 Educators who received Intensive support, 11 Educators received General Support, through grants and technical assistance
- 115 Educators participated in trainings
